Lay a marker on the page and trace around it to make a door frame for the sides and top of your doorway.



Use a marker to put red on the side posts and the top post. That's where God told his people to put lamb's blood.



When God saw the blood on the doors, he passed by those houses. He didn't take the sons from these families.
